



2010 Annual Report


The Douglas County Fire Department is a career emergency services department. We employ one hundred fifty-four (154) career certified personnel and four (4) non-certified administrative personnel. The department responds to an area of 202 square miles and operates ten (10) full time stations.

There are no fire related fatalities to report during 2010


The Douglas County Fire Department responded to **13,503** requests for assistance during the **2010** calendar year.
