**THIS WEEK IS NATIONAL TELECOMMUNICATORS WEEK!**

**National Public Safety Telecommunicators Week (NPSTW) is the time when people from all over the public safety field and beyond express appreciation for the people who make telecommunications work. The week was started by Association of Public-Safety Communications Officials (APCO) member, Patricia Anderson in 1981 in Contra Costa, California and has grown into a national celebration. In 1991, the second full week of April was proclaimed National Public Safety Telecommunications Week by Congress and is celebrated each year by APCO International and public safety communications organizations across the nation.**

**DCSO ACTIVITY**

On 4/12/2010 Patrol Shift "A" Deputy Northcutt responded to Binford Place in Douglasville on a domestic dispute involving a juvenile. A 13 year old male had left the residence without his parent's permission. This juvenile was also on probation for fighting at school. The juvenile was located and placed under arrest.

On 4/12/2010 Patrol Shift "A" Deputy R. Jones was sent to North Summers Circle in Douglasville reference to a fight. Jones found three combatants and three others may have fled the scene. Two subjects were treated by EMS and one subject was arrested.

On 4/12/2010 Patrol Shift "A" Deputy Ernst responded to an alarm at Beulah Baptist Church in Lithia Springs. Deputy Ernst and a key holder did a security check on the location and found the alarm to be false.

On 4/12/2010 Patrol Shift "A" Deputy Northcutt went to Carroll County to pick up a male subject that had warrants out of Douglas County.

On 4/12/2010 Patrol Shift "A" Deputy R. Jones received a BOLO on a suspected drunk driver west bound on I-20 near Tyson Road. Jones found the car and made a traffic stop. The driver advised Jones that he had consumed too much to drink and was going to Villa Rica from Buckhead. Jones conducted some field sobriety tests and found the driver to be less safe. A test was performed on the Intox at DCSO with the driver's results being .235 gms.

On 4/12/2010 Patrol Shift "A" deputies assisted Cobb County and Austell officers on a manhunt in the area of Maxham Road and Old Alabama. A 26 year old male was intoxicated, armed with a pistol, and making suicide threats. The subject was last seen in the wooded area of the listed intersection. The subject was located with a broken leg and surrendered without incident.
