37.) Government No-Idling Policy

Adopt a no-idling policy for local government vehicles.

DESCRIPTION OF MEASURE

The local government has adopted a policy or ordinance regarding vehicle idling times. The policy restricts the allowed time that municipal vehicles may idle when not directly engaged in the line of duty. The local government has a procedure in place to ensure employees are educated about the policy/ordinance.

DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED FOR CREDIT

- ✓ A copy of the policy or ordinance with date of adoption
- ✓ A description of the procedure to ensure all employees know about the policy

Douglas County has a fleet policy limiting the idling times of city owned vehicles (depending on vehicle type and function). Emails with a description of the policy limiting the idling time to 10 seconds have been sent to all employees driving a county vehicle.
