



Personal sound systems in booths are prohibited unless all emitted sound is contained to the individual booth.

No alcohol, drugs, or guns are permitted on the Courthouse grounds. Violators may be arrested and prosecuted by the Douglas County Sheriff's Department.

### Public Address/Sound System

The Festival public address/sound system is reserved only for use by event staff. No vendor/exhibitor/political candidate/elected official/other person may speak over the public address/sound system. The sound system is reserved for musical entertainment, Festival announcements, sponsor recognition, exhibitor and honoree recognition, emergency/public safety announcements, and program notes.

No announcements of giveaways, booth specials, etc., will be made over the public address/sound system for vendors/exhibitors.

If a vendor holds a raffle, the winning ticket/name can be made by event staff over the public address/sound system.

### Performances

Musical performances are limited to choral groups invited by the festival to perform.

### Banners and Signs

Banners displayed on the Courthouse railings, along Hospital Drive or Dorris Road, and at all non-booth locations are limited to the event itself and sponsors. No vendors/exhibitors may place signs or banners at any locations other than their booth space, including political candidates/parties/issues. Sponsors of the activities (train, inflatable game area, carnival rides, etc.) may place their signs and banners on the ride, ride fencing, and ride entry booth.

### Sponsorships

September Saturdays expenses are paid for through the generosity of sponsors. There are multiple levels of sponsorships, as follows.

Presenting Sponsorship	\$3,000	
Gold/Exclusive Sponsorship	\$1,500	
Silver/Non-Exclusive Sponsorship	\$ 500	
Activity Sponsorship	\$1,500	(train, inflatable game area, carnival rides, etc.)

Sponsorships allow the company to have multiple spaces, premium event locations, advance advertising/logo/brand identification, event announcements, and other benefits.

Political candidates/parties/issues may be sponsors, but due to equal time provisions, will not receive the advance advertising and event announcements. September Saturdays is broadcast live on dctv23, the Douglas County government access cable television channel on Comcast with simulcast on the County web site at [www.CelebrateDouglasCounty.com](http://www.CelebrateDouglasCounty.com), and FCC equal time rules apply.

Political sponsorships are not exclusive, and are available only at the Silver and Activity levels.
