

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Douglas County Board of Commissioners is authorized to adopt ordinances and regulations for the governing and policing of the unincorporated area of the County for the purpose of protecting and preserving the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the County; and

WHEREAS, Douglas County, Georgia adopted an emergency management local ordinance on July 19, 2011;

WHEREAS, the Douglas County Board of Commissioners has determined that the current Douglas County Code regarding emergency management needs to be updated;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Douglas County Board of Commissioners that the following Sections of the Douglas County Code of Ordinances be amended as follows:

Section 7.7-2(a)(4)(d)(3) shall be amended by striking the word “firearms” from the text. The edited text shall read as follows:

“To suspend or limit the sale, dispensing or transportation of alcoholic beverages, explosives, and flammable liquids and substances;”

Section 7.7-2(a)(4)(d)(7) shall be amended to follow the Association of County Commissioners of Georgia’s recommended changes. The edited text shall read as follows:


“To utilize public property when necessary to cope with the emergency or disaster or when there is compelling necessity for the protection of lives, health and welfare; and/or the property of citizens;”

BE IT RESOLVED, that these changes shall become effective upon adoption.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with this Ordinance are repealed.




