This **Addendum No.1**, to Douglas County's Invitation to Bid for Inmate Medical Services for the Douglas County Sheriff's Department, is hereby issued to provide clarification to the Bid in the following particulars only, and is made a part of the Bid document.

1. How many copies of the proposal should bidders submit? 1 original, 3 copies
2. What is the start date for this contract? January 1, 2016
3. Please confirm that the proposal due date is June 12, as fourth and final page of the RFP letter states that box labels should read "6/8/2015." June 12, 2015 is the Due Date.
4. Please confirm how many days per week the Medical Director/Physician should be on-site. The second page of the RFP letter says two days, while page 1 of the actual RFP says three days. Physician 3 days per week, Mid-level 2 days per week opposite the physician
5. Please confirm how many days per week the Mental Health Professional should be on-site. The third page of the RFP letter says one day, while page 2 of the actual RFP says two days. 2 days per week
6. Please provide the current staffing plan, including number of FTEs.

Please provide statistics regarding the number of inmates currently receiving dialysis. Current provider is Fresenius but new vendor will be off-site and not the responsibility of the medical provider
13. Who are the current laboratory and X-ray providers? Unknown. Services part of the current medical provider contract.
14. Please provide names and contact information for the specialty providers who come on-site to provide services. All specialty providers that come to the jail are under the supervision of current medical provider

10. Medical Services:

a. Inmates needing medical treatment must submit a sick call request through the computer kiosk located in the cellblock. Inmate should provide as much information as possible regarding symptoms or problems in their request. Sick call is normally conducted five (5) days per week for non-emergency medical complaints. Those inmates assigned to supermax should submit their medical request to the medical staff member assigned to that area.

b. Notify jail staff and follow their instructions in the event of a medical emergency. Inmates who request emergency medical treatment when no true emergency exists may be subject to disciplinary action and/or criminal charges.

c. All incoming or prior prescriptions and/or medications must be approved by the jail's medical provider.

d. Georgia law authorizes the Sheriff to deduct money from your inmate account when you request medical treatment and/or medications. Money will not be deducted when the jail requires you to undergo medical examination or treatment. The full amount of 12 any



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medical procedure may be deducted from an inmate's account if the treatment is for an injury that is self-inflicted. Inmates in custody from other jurisdictions may not have money deducted from their account for medical based on their contract.

e. The following fees will be charges to an inmates account for medical service co-payments:

- Sick Call \$5.00
- Dental Call \$5.00

f. Inmates covered under health insurance will be required to furnish insurance information if needed.

Note: No inmate will be denied any medical care because of inability to pay the copay amount.

11. Medicine Call:

a. Medicine call is normally conducted at 8:00 A.M. to 6:30 P.M., seven (7) days a week. The medicine is brought to your cellblock door and announced. It is **Your** responsibility to report to the officer at the cellblock door if you are to receive medication. Jail staff **will not** personally wake inmates nor wait after the last inmate in line receives their medication. Non-prescription medications are available (in limited amounts) on the commissary. Inmates whose condition, worsens for failure to take your prescribed medication will be charged the full amount of any required follow-up treatment and prescription.

b. You must take your medication followed by a drink of water and open your mouth for inspection while at the cellblock door. Failure to comply with these instructions may result in disciplinary actions, denial of or delay in receiving medications. Hoarding medication or possession of medication not prescribed to you-shall result in disciplinary action and may include criminal charges. It may also be cause for immediate change in your inmate classification and housing.

c. You are required to have your inmate identification with you before you receive medications.
