

Directions to Douglas County Cemeteries

Ayres-Stovall Family Cemetery

From I-20, take Exit 30 south on Post Road 3.2 mi to N. Helton Road. Turn right and go 3.1 mi. to cemetery on left side of road. Shoulder parking available on North Helton. Watch for fast traffic.

Baggett Family Cemetery

From I-20, take Exit 34 south on Bill Arp Road (GA 5) 0.1 mi. to Douglas Boulevard. Turn right and go 0.8 mi. to Bright Star Road. Turn left on Bright Star and go 0.6 mi. to Cowan Mill Road (4-way stop). Turn right on Cowan Mill and go 0.6 mi. to Cowan Mill Church which is on the right. Just past the church, turn right on Baggett (Lake) Road. Go to the end of the road where cemetery is on the right side in plain view. Parking is available in front of the cemetery.

Ben Hill Road Cemetery

From I-20, take Exit 37 north on Fairburn Road (GA 92) 0.7 mi. Turn right on Duralee Lane (Regions Bank on right) and follow it 1.3 mi. to Bankhead Highway (US 78). Turn right on Bankhead and go 1.8 mi. to Ben Hill Road on the left. Turn onto Ben Hill and go 0.9 mi. to cemetery alongside a driveway at 4661 Ben Hill. This is private property and requires permission to visit. Contact cemetery commission at 770-920-7593 to make arrangements.

Carnes-Milam Family Cemetery

From I-20, take Exit 34 south on Bill Arp Road (GA 5) 0.1 mi. to Douglas Boulevard. Turn right and go 0.8 mi. to Bright Star Road. Turn left on Bright Star and go 0.6 mi. to Cowan Mill Road (4-way stop). Turn right on Cowan Mill and go 2.0 mi. to the stop sign at Mason Creek Road. Turn left onto Mason Creek and go 0.3 mi. to the driveway at 3819 (right side of road). The cemetery is along the left side of the drive at its highest point. Be careful not to block the drive as there are several homes at the end of it. This is private property and requires permission to visit. Contact cemetery commission at 770-920-7593 to make arrangements.

Chapel on the Hill Cemetery

From I-20, take Exit 36 and go south 4.8 mi. on Chapel Hill Road. The road forks in front of Holly Springs Elementary School, and the cemetery is in the "v" formed by the fork in the road. Park on the Chapel Hill Road (left) side of the fork, as the shoulder is too narrow on the West Chapel Hill side. Watch for speeding cars.

Cold Spring Cemetery

From I-20, take Exit 30 south on Post Road 3.2 mi to cemetery on left.

Connally Family Cemetery

From I-20, take Exit 37 and go south 5.3 mi. on Fairburn Road (GA 92) to the junction of GA 166. Follow GA 166 East toward Atlanta for 1.6 mi. to Riverside Drive (the last street before the bridge that crosses the river into Fulton County). Turn left onto Riverside and follow it 0.3 mi. to 3953 on the left at the end of the road. The cemetery is at the rear of this property – it is private property and requires permission to visit. Contact cemetery commission at 770-920-7593 to make arrangements.

Dingler Family Cemetery

From I-20, take Exit 30 south on Post Road 7.5 mi to GA Hwy 166. Turn right and go 2.6 mi to Hannah Road (Marathon gas station on corner). Turn left onto Hannah and go 1.4 mi to Kraft Drive (gravel road). Turn right onto Kraft and go 0.4 mi to cemetery on left at 9699 Kraft Drive. This is private property and requires permission to visit. Contact cemetery commission at 770-920-7593 to make arrangements. Roadside parking on Kraft Drive.

Ephesus Baptist Church Cemetery

From I-20, take Exit 30 south on Post Road to the traffic light at Ephesus Church Road. Turn right onto Ephesus Church Road and go 0.9 mi to cemetery on the left. Parking lot is adjacent to the cemetery.

Ergle-Hix Family Cemetery

From I-20, take Exit 34 north onto Bill Arp Road (GA 5). Go north 0.8 mi. to Bankhead Highway (US 78). Turn left on Bankhead Highway and go 0.8 mi. to cemetery on the left. Parking is available in the church parking lot except on Sundays.

Flat Rock Cemetery

From I-20, take Exit 34 north onto Bill Arp Road (GA 5). Go 0.8 mi north to Bankhead Highway (US 78). Turn left on Bankhead Highway and go 0.2 mi. Turn left on Bright Star Road and go 0.3 mi to cemetery on the right. Parking is available in the paved lot directly behind the cemetery.

Griffith-Giles Family Cemetery

From I-20 take exit 34 and go south 5.2 mi. on Bill Arp Road (GA 5) to Big A Road (Exxon station on the corner). Turn left on Big A and follow it 3.6 mi. to 6361 (last drive on the right before GA Hwy 166). Cemetery is along the right side of the driveway – parking is at the foot of the driveway where it turns off the road. Do not block the private drive. This is private property and requires permission to visit. Contact cemetery commission at 770-920-7593 to make arrangements.

Hallman Family Cemetery

From I-20, take Exit 30 south on Post Road for 0.4 mi. Turn right onto Ephesus Church Road and go 1.2 mi to Clinton Road. Turn right onto Clinton Road and go 0.1 mi. Turn right onto Streetman Road and go 0.5 mi. Turn left onto Streetman Way and stop at the locked pasture gate – property owner's permission is needed to access the cemetery which is about 0.1 mi past the gate, on the left. Contact cemetery commission at 770-920-7593 to obtain permission and make arrangements for gate to be unlocked.

Harper-Hudson Cemetery

From I-20, take Exit 37 north on Fairburn Road (GA 92) for 1.5 mi. Turn left on Bankhead Highway (US 78) for 0.2 mi. and turn right at McCarley Street to cross the RR tracks. Turn left on Strickland Street and follow it 0.2 mi. to Chicago Avenue, which becomes Cedar Mountain Road beyond the city limits. Turn right on Chicago and go 2.1 mi. to Dorris Road. Turn right on Dorris Road for 0.8 mi. to the property gate on the left. The cemetery is approximately 0.25 mi. beyond the gate – driving to it is possible but not with low clearance vehicles. This is posted property with a locked gate. It requires permission to visit and accompaniment by a member of the cemetery commission who has a key. The surrounding land is leased for hunting (no visiting September thru January). Call 770-920-7593 to make arrangements. Limited roadside parking on Dorris Road – watch for speeding vehicles on the blind curve just north of the entry gate.

Holly Springs Cemetery

From I-20, take Exit 36 and go south 4.8 mi. on Chapel Hill Road. The road forks in front of Holly Springs Elementary School – take the right side of the fork which is West Chapel Hill Road. Go 0.5 mi. to the cemetery on the right side of the road. Parking is roadside on narrow shoulder – watch for speeding cars.

Hudson-Dobbs Family Cemetery

From I-20, take Exit 26 and go south 1.3 mi. on Liberty Road. Turn left onto Cole Road. The cemetery is to the left of the driveway at 3910 Cole. The cemetery is not private property, but the driveway is. Contact the cemetery commission at 770-920-7593 to make arrangements to use the driveway for access, or park on Liberty Road and enter through the woods.

Jones-Cook Family Cemetery

From I-20, take Exit 30 and go south 7.3 mi. on Post Road. Turn right onto GA Hwy 166 and follow it 2.7 mi. to Hannah Road (Marathon station on the corner). Turn left on Hannah and go 2.1 mi. to East Carroll Road. Turn right on East Carroll (will become gravel) and follow it 1.3 mi. to West Carroll Road (gravel). Turn right on West Carroll and go 0.6 mi. to the cemetery which is on a rise on the left side of the road.

Keaton Family Cemetery

From I-20, take Exit 26 and go south 2.9 miles on Liberty Road. Cemetery is on the left, across from the mailbox (#4271) on the right. From the locked gate near the road, it is 1000 feet down a trail to the cemetery. This is private property and requires permission to visit. Contact the cemetery commission at 770-920-7593 to make arrangements. Roadside parking on Liberty Road.

Kennedy Family Cemetery

From I-20, take Exit 30 and go north on Post Road to Bankhead Highway (US78). Turn left on Bankhead and then right on Mann Road (right in middle of major road construction as of February 2017). Go 2.0 mi. on Mann Road to cemetery on right side of road – behind brick columns and a locked gate. This is private property and requires permission to visit. Contact the cemetery commission at 770-920-7593 to make arrangements. Parking is at roadside – be very careful about speeding vehicles on Mann Road.

Liberty Grove Cemetery

From I-20, take Exit 37 south on Fairburn Road (GA 92) for 2 mi. Turn left onto Mack Road and go 0.7 mi. to cemetery on the left. Off the road parking available in front of the cemetery.

McLarty Family Cemetery (Benson's Hill)

From I-20, take Exit 30 and go north on Post Road 0.4 mi. Turn left on Mason Creek Road and go 0.1 mi to Bankhead Highway (US78). Cross Bankhead (Mason Creek becomes Mann Road at this point). Go 1.7 mi. on Mann Road and turn right on Cedar Mountain Road. Follow Cedar Mountain 0.5 mi. and turn left on Brittain Road. About 450 feet up Brittain there is an orange and white cemetery sign on the left. The access path belongs to the McLarty Cemetery Association, and visitors are welcome. Follow the path up the hill into the cemetery – path is quite steep and often slippery. Parking is at roadside – be very careful about speeding vehicles on Brittain Road.

Miners/Pine Mountain Cemetery

From I-20, take Exit 30 and go north on Post Road 0.8 mi. Turn left on Bankhead Highway (US 78) and go 3.5 mi. Turn right on Tyson Road and go 0.6 mi. Turn left on Conners Road. Go 0.1 mi and turn right onto Mirror Lake Parkway. Cemetery is 1.0 mi. on the right – plenty of curb parking.

Mt. Carmel Primitive Baptist Cemetery

From I-20, take Exit 37 south on Fairburn Road (GA 92) for 2.0 miles to Bomar Road. Cemetery is on the right side of Fairburn Road, directly across Bomar Road from Mt. Carmel Elementary School. Parking is roadside along Fairburn Road.

Mt. Sinai Church Cemetery

From I-20, take Exit 30 and go south 7.3 mi. on Post Road. Turn right onto GA Hwy 166 and follow it 2.7 mi. to Hannah Road (Marathon station on the corner). Turn left on Hannah and go 2.1 mi. to East Carroll Road. Turn right on East Carroll (will become gravel) and follow it 1.3 mi. to West Carroll Road (gravel). Turn right on West Carroll and go 1.4 mi. to the cemetery on the right side of the road at its intersection with 200 Road.

Neal Family Cemetery

From I-20 take Exit 34 and go south 10 miles on Bill Arp Road (GA 5) to the roundabout. Go $\frac{3}{4}$ of the way around it and go east on GA 166 0.1 mi. to Capps Ferry Road.

Turn right and go south 3 miles to Florence Road (gravel). There is a stop sign 0.3 mi. along Florence where Otley Road enters from the right. Stay to the left and continue another 0.3 mi. to the cemetery. It is out of sight in the woods on the right of the road. This is private property and requires permission to use a neighbor's paved driveway to walk up to the cemetery which is about 25 feet to the right of the driveway at the top of the hill. Call the cemetery commission at 770-920-7593 to make arrangements. Finally, the entire neighborhood is made up of horse farms with very expensive purebred animals. Please be quiet and do not bother or alarm them. Parking is roadside on Florence Road.

Old Providence Cemetery

From I-20, take Exit 30 south on Post Road for 3.2 mi. Turn right on N. Helton Road and go 3.25 mi to a private road with several mailboxes visible. Turn right and you're almost immediately in the middle of the cemetery which straddles the road. Limited roadside parking – be sure not to block the road for several families that live along it. They are congenial and accustomed to seeing cemetery visitors.

Polk Family Cemetery

From I-20, take Exit 30 north on Post Road for 0.8 mi. Turn left on Bankhead Highway (US 78) and go 1.2 mi. Turn right on Richardson Road and go 0.3 mi, crossing the RR tracks to Conners Road. Turn left on Conners and go 0.1 mi. to right shoulder of road. Roadside parking – look for neon-glow flagging tape on a tree just inside the woodline. A few feet further into the woods is the path leading directly to the cemetery – look for the county cemetery sign. This is private property and requires permission to visit. Contact the cemetery commission at 770-920-7593 to make arrangements.

Rice Family Cemetery

From I-20, take Exit 34 south on Bill Arp Road (GA 5) 0.1 mi. to Douglas Boulevard. Turn right and go 0.8 mi. to Bright Star Road. Turn left on Bright Star and go 0.6 mi. to Cowan Mill Road (4-way stop). Turn right on Cowan Mill and go 0.6 mi. to Cowan Mill Church which is on the right. Park in the rear of the church parking lot. There is a trail from there that goes part way to the cemetery which is approximately 1000 feet into the woods. You will need a guide to find it since the trail from the church does not go all the way to the cemetery. It is private property and requires permission to visit. Contact the cemetery commission at 770-920-7593 to make arrangements.

Sticher Family Cemetery

From I-20, take Exit 30 south on Post Road 7.5 mi to GA Hwy 166. Turn right and go 2.6 mi to Hannah Road (Marathon gas station on corner). Turn left onto Hannah and go 1.4 mi to Kraft Drive (gravel road). Turn right onto Kraft and go 0.3 mi (just past 9525 Kraft Drive). On the left side of the road is a downed tree and utility pole (placed to stop ATV traffic from using the path to the cemetery). You can walk around the obstacles and follow the path approximately .25 mi to the cemetery on the right side of the path – look for the county cemetery sign. Roadside parking on Kraft Drive. This is private property and requires permission to visit. Contact cemetery commission at 770-920-7593 to make arrangements.

Strickland-Smallwood Family Cemetery

From I-20, take Exit 30 south on Post Road for 5.1 mi. Turn right on Tyree Road (first right after the Dog River bridge – there is no name sign on the bridge). Go 0.8 mi to Amity Drive (gravel) and turn left. Cemetery is immediately visible on right side of road with shoulder parking.
