

**ORDINANCE AMENDING THE RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT FOR THE  
COUNTY MANAGER**

**WHEREAS**, the Douglas County Board of Commissioners is authorized to adopt ordinances and regulations for the governing and policing of the unincorporated area of the County for the purpose of protecting and preserving the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the County.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Douglas County Board of Commissioners that **Article III (County Manager), Section 2.43 (Experience; residency)** of the Douglas County Board of Commissioners is amended as follows:

**Section 1.**

Article III of the Douglas County Code relating to County Manager is amended by striking "Section 2.43 (Experience; residency)" in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

**Sec. 2-43. - Experience:**


The manager shall be chosen by the board, upon the basis of his executive and administrative qualifications with special reference to his actual experience in and knowledge of the duties of office as set forth in this article.


**Section 2.**


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that all ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with this Ordinance are repealed.


**Section 3.**


This Ordinance is approved and shall become effective on this 21<sup>st</sup> day of February, 2017.
