DOUGLAS COUNTY CEMETERY PRESERVATION COMMISSION
DECEMBER 2, 2016**

The Douglas County *Cemetery Preservation Commission* convened at 1:00 p.m. for its regularly scheduled Commission Meeting.

Board Members Present: Sandy Whittington, Marcia Atkins, John McFall, Roseanne Foley.

Board Members Absent: Erika Harris, Rusty Brannon, Cheryl Brannon, Teresa Noles, James Campbell, Suzanne Sammons (non-voting associate), Don Scarbrough (non-voting associate.)

There being no quorum, the minutes from the September 23, 2016 meeting could not be approved. For the same reason, officers for the 2017 and 2018 term could not be nominated/elected.

Group reviewed cemetery work accomplished since the September meeting – sixteen cemeteries including Forsyth, Stone, Bowden, Ergle-Hix, Flat Rock, Smith, Salt Springs, Sweetwater, Ferguson, Pioneer, New Hope, Holly Springs, Thomasson, Liberty Grove, Connally, Fairview. Inmate crew was not available two days because of observed holidays.

Tentative schedule through the end of December – to include Griffith-Giles, Phillips, Pray, Ayres-Stovall, Old Providence.

Because of the necessity of electing officers before December 31, 2016, the meeting recessed at 1:45 to reconvene at the annual Christmas get-together on December 10 to conduct this essential business.

The next regular meeting of the cemetery commission will be on March 3, 2017, at 1:00 p.m. Field work continues every Thursday, weather permitting.

Meeting reconvened at 6:15 on December 10, 2016, at the home of Rusty and Cheryl Brannon. Present were Sandy Whittington, John McFall, Teresa Noles, James Campbell, Roseanne Foley, Rusty Brannon, and Cheryl Brannon. Minutes of the September 23, 2016 meeting were approved unanimously. Sandy Whittington nominated John McFall for co-chairman, and Teresa Noles nominated Sandy Whittington for co-chairman. Both were elected unanimously.
