

ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Douglas County Board of Commissioners is authorized to adopt ordinances and regulations for the governing and policing of the unincorporated area of the County for the purpose of protecting and preserving the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the County.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Douglas County Board of Commissioners that **Article V of Chapter 14** of the Douglas County Code of Ordinances relating to **Traffic Regulations, Section 14-72(c) (Zones prohibiting trucks with more than six wheels)** is amended as follows:

Section 1.

Douglas County Code Section 14.72(c) relating to “Zones prohibiting trucks with more than six wheels” is hereby amended by adding the following Roads:

**North Baggett Road
Beechwood Drive
Sunset Drive**

Section 2.

Douglas County Code Section 14.72(c) relating to “Zones prohibiting trucks with more than six wheels” is hereby amended by removing the following roads or road segments from the list:

**Douglas Hill Road from Thornton Road to Bullard Road
Factory Shoals Road between State Route 6 and Douglas Hill Road**

Section 3.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with this Ordinance are repealed.

Section 4.

This Ordinance is approved and shall become effective on this 6th day of November, 2018.




