APPROVAL OF MINUTES

There being no quorum present, minutes of October 7, 2014 could not be approved and will not be until at least December 2, 2014.

AGENDA

Group reviewed cemetery work accomplished since the October meeting – eight cemeteries including Sweetwater Town, Ferguson, Liberty Methodist Episcopal, Sharpton, Stewart-Winn, Winn-Watson, Pioneer, and McLarty.

Tentative schedule through early January was discussed – to include Holly Springs, Hallman, Hembree, Keaton, Salt Springs, and Hudson-Dobbs – with three workdays eliminated because of Thanksgiving, Christmas, and New Year holidays.

Discussion of reported Duncan family cemetery on Ben Hill at Boyd. Chairman reported site covered in underbrush – to be checked after a hard freeze kills back the vegetation.

Discussion of items to be purchased before the end of the year at Home Depot, Bicknell Supply, and Ace Hardware, including Stihl line trimmers, D/2 Biological Solution, and maple saplings.

The next regular meeting of the cemetery commission will be on December 2, 2014. Field work continues every Thursday, weather permitting.
