Phase 1 Opening of Boundary Waters Aquatic Center

- Operating hours will be 8am – 5pm, Monday – Friday
- 8am – 10:30am swim, 10:30am – 12pm cleaning/no swimming, 12pm – 5pm swim.
- Must reserve lane space in advance. By calling in or reserving online.

- Lap swim only. No free play or open swim.
- 1 swimmer per lane unless from the same household.
- No more than 11 people total in Comp Pool and Instructional Pool.
- 45 minutes per lane usage.
- No locker room will be available during Phase 1. You must come prepared to swim. If emergency bathrooms available at the front.
- Enter through front door and exit through back door unless utilizing handicap spaces.
- No classes will take place during Phase 1. (Water or Land)
- All patrons must follow social distancing and all other guidelines set by our Health Department and CDC.
- All patrons will be asked to sign a waiver before swimming.
- All patrons will have to go through a screening and temperature check before entering pool.
- All patrons will have to use hand sanitizer before entering pool. Stations will be set up around the facility.
- Workout room will have very limited use. Patrons are required to clean before and after each use.
- Mask must be worn while entering the building and leaving the building.

Please keep in mind this is our Phase 1 opening. Even though other departments may be ahead in their opening this is our first opening since the pandemic hit. We are asking that you be patient with us as we start to open back up as this is all new to us as well. Thank you again for being patient during this time and we look forward to seeing you!
