



GEORGIA WEAPONS CARRY LICENSE

NEW APPLICANT

If you have never had a Georgia Weapons Carry License or your License has been expired more than 30 days, the following **MUST BE PROVIDED**:

- Georgia Driver's License or State-Issued ID (must be valid and must have your **CURRENT Douglas County Address**)
- A completed Weapons Carry License Application \$78.25 cash, money order, or credit card (4.5% service fee)
- Background check via fingerprinting is required and is now completed in office.
- License is valid for 5 years.
- You can save some time by starting your application online at celebratedouglascounty.com/219/probate-court

RENEWAL

If your Georgia Weapons Carry License has not been revoked and is still current, or has been expired no more than 30 days, the following **MUST BE PROVIDED**:

- Georgia Driver's License or State-Issued ID (must be valid and must have your **CURRENT Douglas County Address**)
- Current Weapons Carry License
- A completed Weapons Carry License Application \$35.00 in cash, money order, or credit card (4.5% service fee).
- You may purchase a temporary license for \$1.00
- If your current Georgia Weapons Carry License has been expired more than 30 days, fingerprinting is required again.

Georgia's Firearm Permit Reciprocity

Concealed carry reciprocity/recognition means that two (or more) states have an agreement to honor each other's concealed carry permits. With reciprocity, you must follow the laws of the state in which you are currently located rather than the issuing state. The following is a list of states whose laws recognize a Georgia weapons carry license:

Alabama, Alaska*, Arkansas, Arizona*, Colorado*, Florida*, Idaho, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana*, Maine, Michigan, Mississippi, Missouri, Montana, New Hampshire, North Carolina, North Dakota, Ohio, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, South Carolina, South Dakota, Tennessee, Texas, Utah, Virginia*, West Virginia, Wisconsin*, and Wyoming.

NOTE: Alaska, Arizona, Colorado, Florida, Louisiana, Virginia and Wisconsin recognize only those Georgia licenses issued to persons twenty one years of age or older.

CAUTION! Georgia weapons license holders should familiarize themselves with the individual requirements and limitations on Georgia weapons licenses in any of the states where they may wish to exercise their rights.
